Second Story is an unsigned pop band from the Philadelphia area whose music is primed for the Lilith Fair; warm female vocals, insightful lyrics, and lush musical arrangements.

The band's sound also includes a liberal dose of harmony vocals-- with a total of four former (and current) lead singers in the band, the group's impressive vocal blend is their most recognizable asset. However, it is clear from the first listen to their independently produced CD-- songwriting came first for Second Story. The Second Story 'sound' has been found equally appealing by audiences at in-store appearances, outdoor festivals and rock clubs alike.

In 1998, after several months in the studio, Second Story emerged with their eponymous 11-song CD. Since then, Second Story has played to appreciative audiences all over the Philadelphia area, and the band continues to dazzle spectators with a musically and technically superior show -- a show which rivals the impeccable production of their self-titled independent CD release. Second Story is currently recording their sophomore album, to be released in 2001.
